BARREL AND BREW TOUR

Begin the afternoon at Chatham Hill Winery. The first winery in the Triangle, Chatham Hill Winery, was established in 1999. Believing in a minimalist approach, their wines are produced using traditional methods. Included in the tasting are five wines and a glass of your choosing. Charcuterie will be provided during the tasting.

Next head to Lonerider Brewing Company. Opened in 2009, they are counted amongst the top 150 breweries in the USA. They offer award-winning beers and a great atmosphere. Here you will enjoy a flight of four beers and choose a pint of your choice. Food trucks may be on-site for food purchases on your own.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY FOR ARMED FORCES REUNIONS, INC.

For attendees canceling reunion activities prior to the cut-off date, Armed Forces Reunions, Inc. (AFR) shall process a full refund less the non-refundable AFR registration fee (\$25 per person). Attendees canceling reunion activities after the cut-off date will be refunded to the fullest extent that AFR's vendor commitments and guarantees will allow, less the non-refundable AFR registration fee.

Tour will meet in Pre-Function B and load/unload buses through the glass double doors. Please be at the bus boarding area at least fifteen minutes prior to the scheduled time.

Driver and Staff gratuities are not included in the tour prices.

All tours require a minimum of thirty-five people, unless otherwise noted.

NOTE: There is a limit of one hydraulically lifted scooter or wheelchair per handicap accessible bus. If you use a scooter but can climb the steps to board the bus, either you and/or a person traveling with you must be able to put the scooter in the bus's luggage compartment. Due to liability issues, drivers and tour guides cannot assist with scooters.
